



Woman fined over Internet dog comments

An Ontario woman has been fined \$14,000 after being found guilty of libeling a commercial dog breeder online. Ontario Superior Court Judge Michael Galligan heard that Lorie Gordon of Brockville, Ont., made the comments about the poor health of her black Labrador retrievers on an Internet pet forum. The judge ordered Gordon to pay \$10,000 in damages and \$4,000 in court costs to James, Charlene and Nicole Labombard, the owners of the Shawville, Que.-based Paws R Us Kennel.
